Are you new to English language teaching and wondering how to get entry into the profession?

The **CELTA** (Certificate of English Language Teaching to Adults) is an initial qualification for those with little or no previous teaching experience. CELTA gives you a head start, allowing you to enjoy working as a first-time teacher, in France or Germany.

CELTA is a Cambridge University Exams teaching qualification and is the most widely recognised in the world.

If English isn't your first language this doesn't pose a problem as long as you « have an awareness of the language and a competence in both written and spoken English which will enable you to undertake the course and prepare for teaching a range of levels » (Cambridge guidelines).
