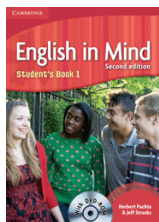

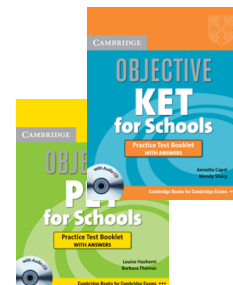

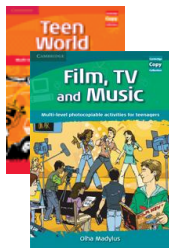
14h50 The New KET for Schools and PET for Schools evaluations
